



Agreement



This is a usage agreement for you and your child and this agreement should only change with prior discussion with you. As the parent you have the right to say 'No' if you feel that this agreement has been compromised or broken.



Laptops and computers should be kept in central locations in your home, this allows you see what you child is doing online.



Time usage should be agreed in advance and should always be ideally after your child has completed his/her homework on week nights



Passwords and usernames should be kept private but it would be a good idea, if a trusted adult within the family has access to this information.



If your child is invited to a friend's house, it is important that you discuss what you feel is acceptable use with the parent. By doing this you can avoid placing your child in an uncomfortable position.



If you notice any change/s in your child's behaviour, it would be advisable to speak to your child or an adult that they trust at school, for support or guidance.
