



## **CANONBURY PRIMARY SCHOOL HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT SEPTEMBER 2011**

At Canonbury Primary School we believe the success of your child depends upon a partnership between the school, children and parents. We ask you to read and sign the following agreement reflecting this partnership.

### **The School will:**

- Care for your child's safety and happiness.
- Encourage your child to achieve their full potential.
- Provide a balanced curriculum at an appropriate level for your child.
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour enabling your child to learn about the value of positive relationships and to develop a sense of responsibility for themselves and others.
- Keep you informed about your child's progress and about general school matters.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you and your child to become involved in the life of the school.
- Educate your child in a way that gives them a global perspective and enables them to understand the value of the diverse society we live in.

### **As a family we will:**

- Make sure our child arrives on time and properly equipped and dressed for school in line with school uniform expectations.
- Make sure our child attends school regularly and provide notification promptly of any absence.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for learning and behaviour.
- Support my child in any work sent home and other home learning opportunities.
- Attend school meetings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Get to know about my child's life at school.
- Understand that everyone is equal.
- Use the school's complaints procedure to raise any concerns I may experience in the correct way.

**Together we will try to:**

- Share any concerns or problems that might affect the child's work or behaviour.
- Support the child's educational and social development.
- Prepare the child to be a confident and happy member of society.
- Celebrate the rich and diverse backgrounds that our school community represents
- **Show respect for the diversity of our school community valuing cultural, ethnic, religious and social differences and ensuring we support the equalities policy of our school.**

**As the child – I will try to:**

- Bring all the equipment I need everyday.
- Be tidy in my appearance.
- Do all my work at school and at home as well as I can.
- Be polite, kind and helpful to others.
- Be well behaved and sensible.
- Take care of school equipment, our building and the school surroundings.
